Hugh will deliver an emotionally engaging talk to the Casterton Community providing us with evidence based, practical strategies to build resilience in our children, grandchildren, friends, family and community members.



**Did you know that:**

- **1 in 4 adolescents have a mental illness**
- **1 in 7 primary schools kids have a mental illness**
- **1 in 5 adults have a mental illness**
- **65% of adolescents do not seek help for mental illness**

Hugh has been working in education for over 13 years. Starting out as a primary school teacher, Hugh has developed and facilitated programs for over 300 schools Australia wide. In 2015, the National Rugby League asked Hugh to design and implement a program for every club in the competition. Off the back of the success of the NRL program, Cricket Australia were quick to follow for all their professional sides. Hugh has also worked closely with the Australian Netball team and 11 of the AFL sides.

Hugh is now working closely with corporate and non for profit organisations to help promote positive mental health strategies in the work place.

As well as the speaking at the Community Night, Hugh will be working with the School children, giving them the skills and strategies needed to build resilience.
